MICHAEL QUINN SULLIVAN TO SPEAK AT THE FEBRUARY MEETING

Michael Quinn Sullivan is president and CEO of Empower Texans, and its premier project, Texans for Fiscal Responsibility. He also serves as treasurer of the Empower Texans PAC.

A graduate of Texas A&M University, Sullivan began his career as a reporter for two daily Texas newspapers and a monthly magazine before leaving journalism to serve as press secretary for congressional candidate. After the successful election, he moved to Washington, DC, to serve in the congressman's Capitol office. He left the government payroll in 1999 to serve as director of communications for an online news service. During that time he also taught classes on effective communications for conservative leaders. Sullivan was brought back to Texas in 2001, when he was asked to serve as director of media and government relations for the Texas Public Policy Foundation. In 2003 he was appointed vice president of the Foundation.

In 2006, he was tapped to lead Empower Texans and begin Texans for Fiscal Responsibility.

As an accomplished writer, Sullivan's commentaries have appeared in newspapers and magazines around the state and nation. He is a frequent guest on talk radio programs, and is regularly called upon to address policy and political issues before groups and organizations across the country. He reads a wide variety of books and periodicals, with a special emphasis on Austrian economic theory.

Sullivan was in A&M's Corps of Cadets, and is an Eagle Scot and avid runner. He lives in Austin with his wife and three children.

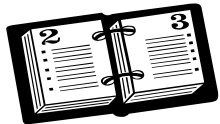
