Richard Hayes

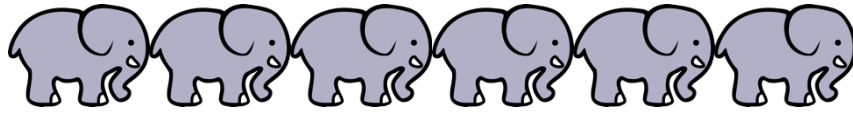
