What a January 2021 we had! While there's a lot wrong with what's happening, there's a lot right! We live in the greatest place in the greatest state in the greatest country ever! And today, we are in the fight to restore our country to its founding values starting with Election Integrity.

We are against the Federal takeover of elections and re-districting outlined in HB1. The following is an idea for communication.

As a registered voter, I am adamantly opposed to the provisions of the proposed "For the People Act".

- The Bill strips power to manage election process from the States and hands it to the Federal government which is unconstitutional. Section 4 Clause 1 of The Constitution of the United States says: "The Times, Places and Manner of holding Elections for Senators and Representatives, shall be prescribed in each State by the Legislature thereof; but the Congress may at any time by Law make or alter such Regulations, except as to the Places of choosing Senators."

For fair elections that allow Americans to have confidence, we need basic reforms that each STATE should adopt, not the Federal Government.

- **Same-day voter registration** should not be allowed. It destroys the ability of local elections officials to ensure voter integrity by eliminating opportunities to verify residency and citizenship requirements.
- **Automatic voter registration** should not be allowed. It increases the opportunity for someone to fraudulently vote for someone that wasn't interested enough in the election process to register.

- As evidenced in our most recent national election, **vote by mail** practices in several states were invitations to fraud and error. The vote by mail practice proven so effective in the state of Texas should become the standard for the nation based on each State's agreement and implementation. Efforts to mail ballots to every registered voter are an invitation to fraud and abuse.
- **Prohibiting** or restricting elections officials' efforts to **remove ineligible voters** from the rolls interferes with their ability to perform their duties in a timely and accurately manner. People who move or die should be removed from the voter rolls in the jurisdiction that they no longer are eligible to vote in.
- **Voting machines** must be manufactured, operated, and owned in the U.S. At no time should ballot casting or counting be connected to the internet. At no time, should voting information be transmitted to individuals or entities outside the U.S. Voting machines should undergo rigorous security testing and approval before being utilized in any election in the U.S.
- Any effort to utilize **public financing for campaigns** should be opposed. Candidates should be able to raise funds based on the support in their district.

ALL Americans should stand firm for the State's Rights including management of the election process clearly articulated in the Constitution. Please vote against HB1.

In addition to fighting HB1, we must stand with our friends in other states to encourage Election Integrity in those states that were in issue during the 2020 election. Contact elected officials in Georgia, Wisconsin, Pennsylvania, Michigan, and Arizona.

Ask them to strengthen their election laws with the following points as examples.

- Executive orders may not change Election Law for more than 7 days without Legislative Action.
- No same day registration.
- Purge the voter registration lists to eliminate people who have moved or died.

- Mail ballots should require an application with a signature that must be verified when received by a bi-partisan panel.
- Voting machines **MUST** not be attached to the Internet, and **ZERO** updates should be downloaded into the system during voting or counts. We understand and agree that voter qualification may be attached to the internet, but **NO** machine that accepts or tabulates votes.

As we all know, 2020 did not turn out the way we expected, and there's plenty of reasons to challenge the integrity of the election. That being said, we **MUST** make a difference with where we are! Thank you for what you've done, are doing and will do! Happy 2021!

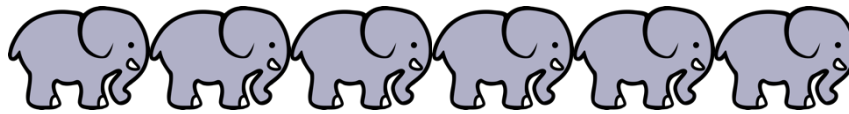
