Precinct 3 Commissioner Larry Walden

Larry Walden is a fifth-generation Parker County native, tracing his lineage back to 1850 with the settlement of his great-great grandfather. Walden grew up 13 miles northwest of Weatherford in the Authon community, attending Garner I.S.D through eighth grade and Millsap High School. He graduated from Weatherford College in 1978 and Tarleton State University with a bachelor's degree in 1980. He went on to complete a Master's in Agriculture in 1981 and a second Master's in Administration in 1996. He made the decision to run for commissioner in 2012.

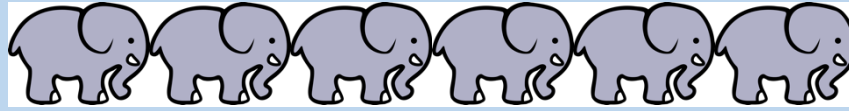
