Robin Younk grew up in Woodhaven, Michigan and wanted a career in law enforcement at an early age.

“Mayor Hooks signed a proclamation on my return from Iraq in 2010 to recognize my service and volunteer services, making March 13, 2010 MSgt Robin Sheehan Day,” she explained.

Younk joined Parker County Republican Women because she wanted to learn more about the people and politics in Texas. She enjoys giving back to the community by acts of service, either community related, a neighbor or friend needing help, or sometimes just a nice gesture like an unexpected gift.


